## Kitchen Goal:

No pine, upgraded handles, oven that heats up quickly, protected upper cupboard, pot & cupboard management

Est Cost \$3300

Budget goal \$3500

## Steps to do

Paint cupboards \$100 total

- 1. Purchase
  - a. Rollers microfiber 3/8" nap, 6"
  - b. Brushes synthetic -round?
  - c. Cabinet paint \$50
    - i. Fusion mineral
    - ii. In between coat
  - d. TSP
  - e. Degloss "crud cutter"
  - f. Tough coat sealer
- 2. Prep
  - a. Hardware
    - Remove hardware
    - Wood putty holes
      - Keep cupboard hole as starting point?
  - b. Clean with tsp/degreaser
    - outside of cupboards/drawers
    - Inside wipe clean
      - clean fully inside shelves & drawers
        - Vacuum bits
        - Quick remove/reorganize/declutter
        - Measure cupboards that will have organizers & declutter/clean well
  - c. Sand with electric sander
    - Quick inside & outside of cupboards
    - Quick drawer fronts
    - Inside of open shelf
    - Wipe damp clean & dry
  - d. Liquid sandpaper
    - Quick wipe over cupboards in crevices
- 3. Paint
  - a. Fusion blog <https://fusionmineralpaint.com/kitchen-makeover-with-fusion-mineral-paint-in-2-simple-steps/> and <https://designertrapped.com/how-to-paint-kitchen-cabinets-the-easy-way/>
  - b. Paint brush details 1 coat
  - c. Roll flats 1 coat
  - d. In-between coat, try rolling only
  - e. Primed 4 times, laminate kept showing through

- f. 2nd coat detail & flats
  - i. 2nd 2nd coat touch ups to cover all primer
- g. Total fusion bottles bought 2, needed 5

#### Backsplash \$200

1. Purchase
  - a. Subway tile
  - b. Mud
  - c. Grout
  - d. Grout sealer
  - e. Sponge
  - f. Caulk
  - g. Wall patch
  - h. Tile straight cutter
  - i. Tile trowel
  - j. Grout floats
  - k. 3 gfi outlets
  - l. Plate covers
2. Replace outlets with gfi
  - a. Swap old outlets with new gfi plugs
  - b. Adjust depth and attach plate covers
3. Prep
  - Remove ugly board backsplash
  - Scrape glue
  - Sand ridges smooth
  - Wash everything
  - Tape plastic over counter
  - Pull out stove/relocate
  - Drop cloth floor
4. Tile
  - Install tile mud /lay

  - Clean mud from tile/work area
  - Grout

  - Clean up site
  - Seal grout
  - Caulk grout

    - a. Pull out drawers x4

5. Island \$50
  - a. Top
    - i. Paint top
    - ii. Remove excess wood
    - iii. Trim
    - iv. Anchor
      - 1) Brackets
    - v. Cut & hinge one side
  - b. Castor Wheels
    - i. Block of wood
  - c. Backing
  - d. Draw front
    - i. Hinges
  - e. Side cutting board or storage
